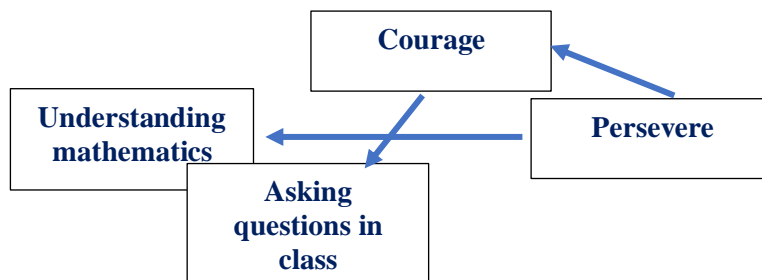


Activity 8. Fine-tune your focus for Map 2.

You are now going to prepare to draw your second Infinity Learning Map. The first thing you need to do is decide which learning area you are going to use to draw your second learning map. After talking with your classmates and teachers about your wedge graph on the previous page, complete a table that shows how you think your ideas are linked. Only select 2, 3 or 4 ideas that you are most interested in improving. In other words, select the ideas that are going to engage you, interest you, excite you in your learning.
