

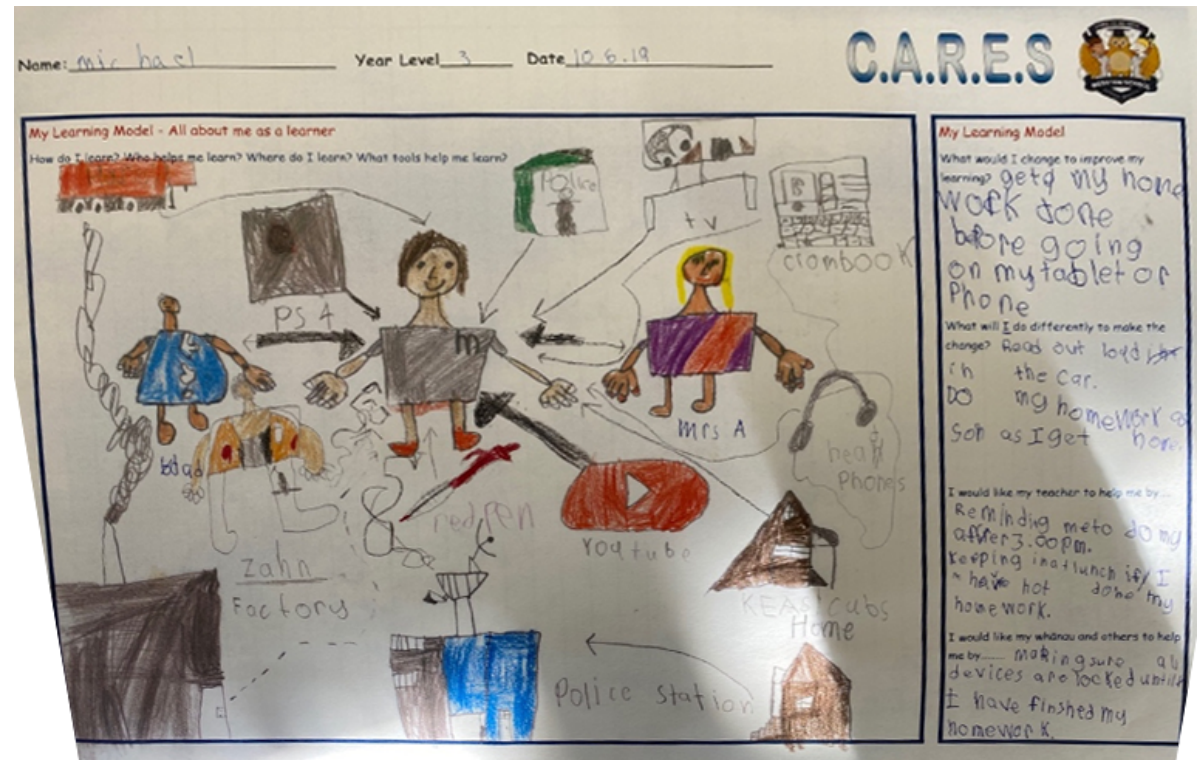
Persevering in Maths
